

Grand County Small Engine opens storefront in Kremmling

Grand County residents and home owners are no strangers to small engines and the need to keep them up and running. Winter sees snowblowers and snowmobiles everywhere, while dreams of getting the boat on the lake or adventuring on the ATV abound. Lawnmowers are out and about in summer, and chainsaws and wood splitters are preparing for cold weather.

Grand County Animal Control reminds public to license dogs

GRAND COUNTY, CO- Grand County Animal Control reminds the public that the 2023 county tags for dog licenses are available. Tags must be purchased annually in January, although they are available year-round. Per county ordinance, all dogs in Grand County, even those in foster care, must be registered and display a current rabies tag and county tag at all times.

The cost for tags is \$5.00 for a fixed dog and \$10.00 for an intact dog. The public can purchase county tags at all of the town halls, at all local veterinarians with the exception of Colburn, and at the Grand County Animal Shelter located at 3475 County Road 57 in Granby. Owners should contact the location of their choice regarding payment methods available. Owners need to show proof of current rabies vaccination in order to be able to purchase a county tag.

Unfortunately, the reality of dogs sometimes becoming lost does happen even in our community. While mandated, registering your dog is also an act of love that gives responders a better chance to reunite a lost pet

with their family. The information you provide when registering your dog is a lifeline. We understand that pets are members of a family and deserve as much protection as we can give them. If you believe that your pet is lost or have found a lost pet call the Animal Shelter at 970-887-2988.

The Animal Shelter also offers a tag engraver with the ability to personalize your pet's name and contact phone number. The cost for small tags is \$6.00 and \$8.00 for large tags. Appointments to make a pet tag can be made by calling the Animal Shelter. The tag engraver was generously provided by Grand County Pet Pals, and all proceeds from the tags go directly back to them.

Grand County Pet Pals is the supportive arm of the Grand County Animal Shelter. It is the local organization dedicated to responsible pet ownership and animal health and supports the spay and neutering of pets in Grand County.

Gray wolves in Colorado

The reintroduction of wolves to northern Colorado has been divisive among locals. Some view wolves as a beneficial presence, helping to restore some of the balance that was lost when the gray wolf disappeared in the 1940s, while others believe that the gray wolf was never actually a native species to the area. Gray wolves are native to North America, but their range has been reduced to northern regions of the United States, including Alaska, Minnesota, Wisconsin, Idaho, and Montana. They believe that reintroduction (or introduction) will aid in maintaining elk and deer populations.

On average, gray wolves tend to be larger than coyotes. Adult gray wolves can weigh up to 80-110 pounds while adult coyotes usually weigh around 20-50 pounds. Gray wolves also tend to be longer as an average adult gray wolf can reach up to 6.5 feet in length while adult coyotes average around 3-4 feet in length.

Others express concern that the presence of wolves increases the danger to locals living in the area and their livestock. They have also pointed out that other apex predators such as the coyote have stepped in to organically manage the big game herds.

Gray wolves are generally not dangerous to humans, but they may attack if they perceive a person as a threat. It is important to remember those wild animals can be



When Susan begins a painting, she has no idea what it will become. By playing with the soft colors and putting layer upon layer (with each layer


drying before another application), multiple veils are created. This allows for the colors to become more intensified organically as she steps into what feels like divine inspiration.
